Requires person with an alcoholic beverage license to carry alcoholic beverage liability insurance under certain circumstances.

2 supplementing Title 33 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, rule, or
8 regulation to the contrary, every person holding a Class A, Class B,
9 Class C, Class D, or Class E license pursuant to Title 33 of the
10 Revised Statutes shall carry a policy of alcoholic beverage liability
11 insurance unless the person carries a commercial general liability
12 policy that provides coverage for alcoholic beverage liability.

14 2. This act shall take effect on the 90th day next following the
15 date of enactment.

20 This bill requires a person holding a Class A, Class B, Class C,
21 Class D, or Class E alcoholic beverage license to carry a policy of
22 alcoholic beverage liability insurance unless the person carries a
23 commercial general liability policy that provides coverage for
24 alcoholic beverage liability.
