21	Under current law, a family member or other person may be
22	appointed as the guardian of a veteran residing in a Department of
23	Military and Veterans' Affairs (DMVA) memorial home.
24	This bill requires the Division of Veterans' Administrative
25	Services in the DMVA to ensure that each veterans' memorial home

holds quarterly town hall meetings with all veterans' guardians, and

persons otherwise having the veteran's power of attorney.
