1	AN ACT concerning reports on the status of the veterans' homes in
2	this State during a public health emergency, and supplementing
3	Title 38A of the New Jersey Statutes.

5	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
6	of New Jersey:

8	1. a. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, rule, or
9	regulation to the contrary, the Adjutant General of the Department
10	of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall transmit a weekly report on
11	the status of the State veterans' homes to the Commissioner of the
12	Department of Health whenever a Public Health Emergency,
13	pursuant to the "Emergency Health Powers Act," P.L.2005, c.222
14	(C.26:13-1 et seq.), has been declared by the Governor and is in
15	effect. The weekly report shall include:
16	(1) the number of residents and staff in each veterans' home,
17	including comparisons to previous reports;
18	(2) any significant health risks posed to the residents and staff in
19	each veterans' home due to the public health emergency;
20	(3) any changes in operating procedures in each veterans' home
21	due to the public health emergency; and
22	(4) the amount of personal protective equipment available to
23	residents and staff at each veterans' home.
24	b. As used in this section:
25	(1) "veterans' home" means the New Jersey Veterans' Memorial
26	Home - Menlo Park, the New Jersey Veterans' Memorial Home -
27	Vineland, and the New Jersey Veterans' Memorial Home - Paramus.
28	(2) "personal protective equipment" means any items commonly
29	used to protect an individual from bacterial or viral infections,
30	including, but not limited to, disinfecting wipes, disposable gloves,
31	disposable gowns, face shields, N95 face masks, surgical masks, or
32	parts thereof.

34	2. This act shall take effect immediately.

39	This bill requires the Adjutant General of the Department of
40	Military and Veterans' Affairs (DMVA) to send weekly reports to
41	the Commissioner of the Department of Health (DOH) on the status
42	of the State's veterans' homes during a public health emergency.
43	The weekly reports would include: (1) the number of residents
44	and staff in each veterans' home, including comparisons to previous

reports; (2) any significant health risks posed to the residents and

staff in each veterans' home due to the public health emergency; (3)
