### **S3942** [1R] GOPAL, SINGLETON

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AN ACT concerning the issuance schedule of Supplemental
 Nutrition Assistance Program benefits and supplementing Title
 44 of the Revised Statutes.

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**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

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8 1. a. The Division of Family Development in the Department 9 of Human Services shall implement an issuance schedule for newly 10 eligible enrollees of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program 11 in which the issuance of benefits is staggered throughout the month, 12 provided that each household shall be issued benefits on or near the 13 same date once a month. The issuance schedule implemented by the division shall comply with the federal regulations outlined at 7 14 15 CRF s.274.2. b. The Commissioner of Human Services shall apply to the 16

Food and Nutrition Service within the United States Department of
Agriculture for any necessary waivers or approvals to implement
the provisions of this act.

c. As used in this act, "Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
Program" means the supplemental nutrition assistance program,
established pursuant to the federal "Food and Nutrition Act of
2008," Pub.L.88-525 (7 U.S.C.s.2011 et seq.).

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25 2. The Commissioner of Human Services shall adopt rules and
26 regulations, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act,"
27 P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), as may be necessary to
28 implement the provisions of this act.

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30 3. This act shall take effect <sup>1</sup>[on the first day of the fourth 31 month next] <u>one year</u><sup>1</sup> following the date of enactment, but the 32 Commissioner of Human Services may take such anticipatory 33 administrative action in advance thereof as may be necessary for the 34 implementation of this act.
