Provides project grants under “Securing Our Children’s Future Fund” for career and technical education at county colleges; appropriates \$26,456,996.

1 AN ACT concerning project grants under the “Securing Our
2 Children’s Future Fund” to provide career and technical
3 education at county colleges and making an appropriation.
4

5 1. a. There is appropriated from the “Securing Our Children’s
6 Future Fund,” established pursuant to section 13 of P.L.2018, c.119, to
7 the Secretary of Higher Education the sum of \$25,956,996 to provide
8 career and technical education grants to county colleges. Project grants
9 shall be approved in the amounts set forth in subsection b. of this
10 section.

11 b. Project grants shall be awarded in the amounts as follows:

12 (1) \$4,000,000 to Atlantic Cape Community College in Mays
13 Landing, Atlantic County;

14 (2) \$1,937,711 to Brookdale Community College in Lincroft,
15 Monmouth County;

16 (3) \$4,000,000 to County College of Morris in Randolph, Morris
17 County;

18 (4) \$2,737,317 to Hudson County Community College in Jersey
19 City, Hudson County;

20 (5) \$4,000,000 to Mercer County Community College in West
21 Windsor, Mercer County;

22 (6) \$2,997,691 to Middlesex County College in Edison, Middlesex
23 County;

24 (7) \$2,104,752 to Ocean County College in Toms River, Ocean
25 County;

26 (8) \$2,650,500 to Union County College in Cranford, Union
27 County; and

28 (9) \$1,529,025 to Warren County Community College in West
29 Washington, Warren County.

31 2. There is appropriated from the “Securing Our Children’s Future
32 Fund” to the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education the sum of
33 \$500,000 for the administrative costs of the agency in implementing
34 the provisions of the “Securing Our Children’s Future Bond Act,”
35 P.L.2018, c.119.

37 3. The expenditure of sums appropriated by this act shall be subject
38 to the provisions and conditions of the “Securing Our Children’s
39 Future Bond Act,” P.L.2018, c.119.

41 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

46 This bill appropriates a total of \$26,456,996 from the “Securing
47 Our Children’s Future Fund.” Under the bill, \$25,956,996 is
48 appropriated for career and technical education grants to the State’s
