1	AN ACT concerning alarm business professionals and locksmiths
2	and supplementing P.L.1997, c.305 (C.45:5A-23 et seq.).

4	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
5	of New Jersey:

7	1. a. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, rule, or
8	regulation to the contrary, whenever the license number of a
9	licensee of the Fire Alarm, Burglar Alarm and Locksmith Advisory
10	Committee is required to be included in an advertisement, it shall be
11	permissible to instead use the address of the Internet website of the
12	company employing the licensee so long as the website makes the
13	license number of the licensee readily accessible to the public.
14	b. As used in this section:
15	"Advertisement" means an attempt, directly or indirectly, by
16	publication, dissemination, or circulation in print, electronic, or
17	other media, to induce any person or entity to enter into an
18	agreement to purchase burglar alarm, fire alarm, or electronic
19	security system services or goods related thereto.
20	"Electronic media" means radio, television, telephone, internet,
21	and other electronic means of communication.
22	"Print media" means business cards, newspapers, magazines,
23	periodicals, professional journals, telephone directories, circulars,
24	handbills, flyers, billboards, signs, direct mail, match covers and
25	other items disseminated by means of the printed word.

27	2. This act shall take effect immediately.
