SYNOPSIS

Condemns inflammatory rhetoric and abuse targeted at Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders and recognizes the contributions of these individuals and communities in New Jersey.

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION condemning abuse against individuals who 2 are Asian American and Pacific Islander and recognizes the 3 impacts made on this State and country by Asian American and 4 Pacific Islander heritage. 5 6 WHEREAS, Asian American and Pacific Islanders are a significant and 7 important community in New Jersey; and 8 WHEREAS, The members of these communities have made significant 9 contributions to the culture and economy of this State; and 10 WHEREAS, Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month is 11 celebrated each May and serves to recognize the contributions and 12 influence of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders to the history, culture, and achievements of the United States; and 13 14 WHEREAS, There are approximately 2 million Asian American owned 15 businesses in the United States that generate over \$700 billion in 16 annual revenue and employ nearly 4.5 million workers; and 17 WHEREAS, Over 2 million Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders are working across the United States on the frontline of the COVID-19 18 pandemic in fields such as health care, law enforcement, first 19 20 responders, transportation, supermarkets, and other service 21 industries; and WHEREAS, Twenty three million Asian Americans and Pacific 22 23 Islanders account for seven-percent of the population of the United 24 25 WHEREAS, New Jersey has nearly 1 million Asian Americans and 26 Pacific Islanders residing in the State, about 10 percent of the State 27 population; and WHEREAS, The use of derogatory and offensive comments against 28 29 Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders has increased during the 30 COVID-19 pandemic; and WHEREAS, The World Health organization and the United States 31 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recognize that naming 32 33 COVID-19 by its geographical location or linking the virus to a 34 specific ethnicity may lead to violence against certain communities; 35 WHEREAS, Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, there has 36 37 been an increase in reports of hate crimes and incidents against individuals who are Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders; and 38 39 WHEREAS, The advocacy group Stop AAPI Hate, which tracks 40 incidents of hate against individuals who are Asian American and Pacific Islander, reports that it received more than 2,800 reports of 41 hate incidents directed at members of the community nationwide 42 43 from March to December 2020; and 44 WHEREAS, In March 2020 alone, violence against these communities 45 included: a woman wearing a mask being kicked and punched at a 46 New York City subway station; two children and two adults being stabbed at a grocery store in Texas; a couple assaulted in 47

1 Philadelphia, and a 16 year old boy attached by bullies in 2 California; and

WHEREAS, Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders should not live in fear of attack and discrimination and verbal and physical attacks against these communities are intolerable and should be condemned by all government officials and residents of this State; now, therefore,

This resolution condemns any discrimination against Asian American and Pacific Islander communities and recognizes the significant contribution that these communities make on a daily basis to the State of New Jersey and the country.

Asian Americans and pacific Islanders are one of the fastest growing racial groups in New Jersey and it is imperative to build understanding and bring disparate communities in New Jersey together. New Jerseyans of Asian and Pacific Islander descent represent roughly 10 percent of the State's total population, the third highest proportion in the country. These communities contribute nearly half a million eligible voters to the State, own roughly 81,000 firms with combined revenue of roughly \$44 billion, and buying power of roughly \$57 to \$75 billion. Additionally, un the United States, over 2 million Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders are working as essential workers on the frontline of the COVID019 pandemic in fields such as health care, law enforcement, first responders, transportation, supermarkets, and other service industries.

In the past year, since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, there has been a surge in abuse against Asian American and Pacific Islander families and communities. Harassment has ranged from being spat on and verbally abused to incidents of physical assault. In New Jersey, Stop AAPI Hate reported nearly 50 incidents related to the COVID-19 pandemic of Asian American and Pacific Islander discrimination between March 19, 2020 and December 31, 2020.

- 5 and communities marks an increase from the previous year. The
- 6 United Nations has detailed "an alarming level" of racially
- 7 motivated violence and other hate incidents against Asian
- 8 Americans and Pacific Islanders. This cannot continue in the state
- 9 of New Jersey and the country.
- The State of New Jersey condemns and denounces acts of
- 11 racism, violence, xenophobia, and intolerance against Asian
- 12 American and Pacific Islander communities and individuals. The
- 13 State additionally recognizes and promotes the contributions made
- 14 by the Asian American and Pacific Islander communities
- 15 throughout the State and country.
