4	BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

7	1. Notwithstanding any law, order, rule, or regulation to the
8	contrary, no State, county, or local government employee, entity, or
9	elected official, and no private or public school shall directly or
10	indirectly require an individual who is 18 years of age or younger to
11	undergo the administration of an influenza vaccine or any other
12	injection, medication, or procedure that is designed to provide
13	immunity from influenza.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill prohibits a government entity or school from requiring influenza vaccinations for persons who are 18 years of age or younger.

Under the bill, no State, county, or local government employee, entity, or elected official, and no private or public school is to directly or indirectly require an individual who is 18 years of age or younger to undergo the administration of an influenza vaccine or any other injection, medication, or procedure that is designed to provide immunity from influenza.
