The commission will be available to take testimony from 4:00 to 6:00 P.M. and 7:00 to 9:00 P.M. Directions:

New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 4 towards Camden.
Bear right after toll onto Route 73 North.
Exit onto I-295 South.
Take exit 29 for Collingswood.
Follow signs to Route 30 West (White Horse Pike).
Stay on Route 30 for approximately 4 miles through Oaklyn and across Newton Creek.
You will come to a traffic light at Collings Avenue (the Parkview Apartments will be on the corner).
Turn right onto Collings Avenue.
After you go under the Patco high speedline overpass, the community center will be on the right.
