

NJDOT FOLLOW-UP RESPONSES
TO ASSEMBLY BUDGET COMMITTEE QUESTIONS

Assemblywoman Watson-Coleman:

- *Please provide to the committee a summary of contracts awarded to female and minority owned businesses.*

The following table is a summary of minority and women owned business participation on federally funded transportation projects during Federal Fiscal Year 2010. This includes both NJDOT and locally sponsored projects.

- *Please include the contract recipient, monetary size of contract, and percentage of total contract monies provided to female and minority owned businesses.*
 - The NJDOT awarded \$580,625,112 in federally funded contracts in FFY 2010.
 - The NJDOT awarded and/or committed \$87,122,959 in federal contracting opportunities to minority and women owned businesses in FFY 2010.
 - Minority and women owned businesses received 15.01% of the NJDOT's federally funded contracts during FFY 2010.

The Department has attached a detailed summary of its minority and women owned business participation for FFY 2010.

Assemblymen Coutinho and Greenwald:

- *Please provide the committee with an estimate of the amount of annual funding that the transportation capital program would require on an annual basis to bring the entire transportation system into a state of good repair over roughly the next 25 years. This would mean that on the twenty-fifth year there would be no structurally deficient bridges and the percentage of State Highway pavement in acceptable condition is at least 90% and roadway and transit system capacity expands in proportion to population growth.*

To bring the state's bridges, pavement and road and transit capacity to the levels you specify in 25 years, we estimate that an investment of over \$3 billion per year would be required. These figures do not include costs to improve the county and municipal system or other support costs. Transit expansion needs for the next 10 years are covered under the current capital plan based on current ridership projections. Beyond 10 years, there could be additional needs.

- *Please provide the committee with an estimate of the amount of annual funding that the transportation capital program would require on an annual basis simply to maintain the current status quo of road and bridge conditions for the transportation system.*

To maintain the current state-owned road and bridge conditions, we estimate that an annual investment of \$800 million per year is required. This includes \$200 million in our roads and \$600 million in the state's bridges. These figures do not include costs to maintain the county or municipal system.

Assemblyman Greenwald:

- *Please provide to the committee information about the source of pay go money and debt service money that will be provided for FY 2012 through 2016 in the new transportation capital plan on a year by year basis. For additional money that will be derived from General Fund sources, it was noted during the revenue hearing that tax revenue to the General Fund is not expected to increase substantially over the next few years, so new funding from the General Fund will likely require a reduction somewhere else in the State budget. The committee would like to know which programs will be reduced in order to provide the necessary General Fund money for the transportation capital program.*

See the attached two charts, which summarize the pay as you go and debt service for the NJ Capital Transportation Program, including the Transportation Trust Fund, from fiscal 2012 through 2016.

Concerning the programs that may be affected by the commitment of General Fund resources to the transportation capital program, it is very difficult to project future revenue trends and spending requirements with the degree of accuracy that is required to properly answer this question. Each State Budget is unique, and the set of choices that ultimately will be presented is hard to predict in advance. That said, it should be noted that the New Jersey Turnpike Authority will be providing much of the pay as you go funding that is reflected in the proposed transportation capital plan. With all of these considerations in mind, the State Treasurer believes that the impact on the General Fund will be manageable.

- *Please provide to the committee information about whether the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey will be using borrowed money in order to provide the expected \$1.8 billion in capital support for the transportation capital program.*

The following narrative was furnished by the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey.

To provide the expected capital support for the transportation capital plan, the Port Authority (if permitted by applicable statutory and contractual obligations) will have to borrow money, through the issuance of debt. The Port Authority raises the necessary funds for the improvement, construction or acquisition of its facilities generally upon the basis of its own credit. The Port Authority has no power

to levy taxes or assessments. Its bonds, notes and other obligations are not obligations of the two States or of either of them, and are not guaranteed by the States or by either of them.

The revenues of the Port Authority are derived principally from the tolls, fares, landing and dockage fees, rentals and other charges for the use of, and privileges at, certain of the Port Authority's facilities; other facilities operate at a deficit, do not generate surplus revenue or are non-revenue producing to the Port Authority. It is expected that increases from time to time will continue to be necessary in the Port Authority's tolls, fares, landing and dockage fees, rentals and other charges, or that either planned capital expenditures will be curtailed or reductions in services and associated expenditures will occur, or both, so that the costs of operations, including expenses incurred with respect to obligations issued in connection with the acquisition of certain equipment by the Port Authority, the payment of debt service and the fulfillment of Port Authority statutory, contractual and other commitments, will continue to be provided for in accordance with the requirements and agreements with the holders of Port Authority obligations.

The costs of operations, including expenses incurred with respect to obligations issued in connection with the acquisition of certain equipment by the Port Authority, and debt service are expected to be derived from gross operating revenues and income on investments, and capital funds are expected to be provided primarily through the application, as appropriate, of the proceeds of issues of Port Authority obligations and from other moneys legally available for such purposes. In order to provide sufficient funds expeditiously and on a temporary basis for certain expenditures, the Port Authority's annual budget and business planning process provides for temporary applications of available moneys (other than proceeds of Port Authority obligations), subject to reimbursement through the issuance of Port Authority obligations to permit permanent application of such amounts for other authorized purposes.

From time to time, at the request of the Governors of the States of New York and New Jersey, the Port Authority participates in certain programs that are deemed essential to the continued economic viability of the States and the region. These programs, which are generally non-revenue producing to the Port Authority, are addressed by the Port Authority in its budget and business planning process in the context of the Port Authority's overall financial capacity.

The purposes for which the Port Authority's various funds, including revenues, can be applied are set forth in various statutes and in the agreements with the holders of its obligations. To determine the moneys which are, or will become available, to meet the requirements of any of the Port Authority's obligations, it is necessary to examine the statutes and resolutions affecting the particular issue.

- ***Please provide to the committee a list of communities that have been approved for red light cameras and a list of those communities that have had their red light camera permission rescinded for failure to move forward with the installation of cameras. Also please provide the approval and rescind dates.***

A total of 27 municipalities have received authorization to install red light cameras, and two of those communities have had their authorizations rescinded. The 25 currently-authorized municipalities and their authorization dates are as follows:

Assemblyman O'Scanlon:

- ***Please provide the committee with data from an engineering study that measured yellow light time at red light cameras, and provide information about whether the yellow light signal time is sufficient to promote safety and address concerns that the yellow light signal time might be deliberately reduced in order to obtain greater traffic fine revenue.***

New Jersey has not undertaken a yellow time study, as our yellow times are determined by nationally accepted standards. Our guiding principle is the 2009 (current) edition of the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways* (MUTCD), which states in *Section 4D.26*: The duration of the yellow change interval shall be determined using engineering practices. The MUTCD is adopted in New Jersey through existing motor vehicle law, specifically *Title 39 of the Revised Statutes*.

The accepted engineering practice to determine yellow change intervals is from the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE), 1994: $y = t + (v / 2a + 2Gg)$ where y is the length of the yellow interval, t is driver perception-reaction time (recommended as 1 second), v is the speed limit (feet per second), a is the deceleration rate (10 feet per second per second), g is gravitational acceleration (32 feet per second per second), and G is the approach grade, usually 0%. Using this formula, a speed limit of 45 MPH results in 4.3 seconds of required yellow clearance time.

Since New Jersey does not use tenths of seconds for yellow time calculations, we round up, utilizing a generally conservative form of the ITE formula: $y = v$ (in MPH) divided by 10. This formula demands a yellow time of 4.5 seconds for 45 MPH, but since no tenths are used, the yellow time is rounded up, meaning 45 MPH results in 5 seconds of yellow clearance time. Knowing that New Jersey follows the requirements of the MUTCD and is almost always conservative in yellow time calculations, no yellow time study or data was required.

It was understood early on that some states did shorten yellow times for their red light running programs. This practice is forbidden in New Jersey. For non-state signals, municipalities are required, as part of their initial applications, to certify to the speed limit versus yellow time signal needs. Municipalities are also required to submit six-month operational certifications regarding the cameras and related equipment. Should any community change yellow times and the NJDOT finds out, its authorization will be rescinded immediately.
